

What do Respiratory Therapy and other Healthcare Support Technicians do?

Respiratory therapy and other healthcare support technicians are sought after entry-level professionals in healthcare. They work as part of a team with other healthcare professionals in many different types of healthcare settings. Respiratory therapy technicians ensure treatments are being received correctly, keep a record of the patient's therapy and assesses the patient's response to treatment. Other types of healthcare support technicians include dietetic, pharmacy, psychiatric, surgical, and ophthalmic technicians. All healthcare support technicians work closely with patients ensuring physician orders are being followed, answering questions and documenting patient care in a variety of clinical healthcare settings.

Training & Educational Opportunities

Respiratory therapy and other healthcare support technicians usually need an associate degree with certification. Many choose to continue their education and seek further licensing in order to advance their career. Courses commonly included in an associate degree program include medical terminology, English, Math, computer skills, and classes for the specific healthcare support technician title being pursued.

As a Respiratory Therapy or other Healthcare Support Technician you will:

- Assess patient's response to treatments and modify treatments according to protocol
- Collect and analyze data directly from the patient, either verbally or through testing
- Maintain accurate records of patient status
