

What do Food Machine Operators do?

Food machine operators operate or tend cooking equipment, such as steam cooking vats, deep fry cookers, pressure cookers, kettles, and boilers, to prepare food products. They typically work in manufacturing environments and may operate computer-controlled or manually operated equipment. This type of work involves frequent physical motion. Operators must be alert and practice safe working habits at all times.

In Kankakee County, employment of food machine operators is expected to increase through 2020!

Training & Educational Opportunities

Food machine operators must have a high school diploma or equivalent. They typically train in apprenticeship programs or on the job and can take classes for certification or an associate degree in food safety, food handling, and other food machine operator related skills.

As a Food Machine Operator you will:

- Listen for malfunction alarms, and shut down equipment and notify supervisors when necessary
- Move control settings to make necessary adjustments on equipment units affecting speeds of chemical reactions, quality, or yields
- Read work orders, recipes, or formulas to determine cooking times, temperatures, and ingredient specifications
- Record production and test data, such as processing steps, temperature and steam readings, cooking time, batches processed, and test results
